Non Uniform Day – Raising money for Library Books

We have decided to have a non-uniform day on Friday 2nd March in order to raise funds to buy some new library books. It is suggested that students give a £1.00 contribution if they choose to wear non dress code to school.

Monday 26th February until Friday 2nd March is National Book Week, there will be lots of activities going on around school linked to this including competitions and a themed food menu on World Book day; students will also all receive a book token.

Students, if they wish, may dress up as a book character of their choice or come in non-dress code. As always, even though it is non dress code day, we expect clothing that is appropriate for working within a school environment. We have made it clear to the students that shorts over tights are not appropriate, neither are 'onesies'. Leggings are acceptable as long as the top that is worn over them is an appropriate length (mid thigh length as a guide). Tops on females must not be too low or cropped. Skirts also need to be an appropriate length. Jeans are allowed however only a small 'rip' effect is permitted and this should be no higher than the knee. Lessons will run as normal, therefore all normal equipment (including Lees Brook PE Kit) is required.
